Inbound Receipts & Put Away

Inbound Orders are received to the dock using Android devices. Damaged goods are received to quarantine locations. Moveable unit ID's (license plates) can be created that give the skid or carton a unique ID, which are used to optimize movement efficiency. WMS123 then guides the user through an intelligent put away process.

Order Fulfillment – Pick, Pack &

WMS123 Pick, Pack & Ship will streamline outbound order fulfillment operations utilizing Android device applications that optimize efficiency, reduce lead-time and eliminate errors and offers the following benefits:

- > Completely paperless fulfillment
- > Pick paths optimization that reduces warehouse travel
- Supports zone and wave picking
- A. Orders are consolidated into pick lists based on client fulfillment rules
- B. Pick lists are assigned to devices for processing
- C. Scanner apps guide users through the pick path to minimize warehouse travel
- D. Locations, products and quantities are picked to mobile inventory location (totes)
- E. Picks from totes or Pallet IDs are sent to Packing Stations for containerization. Each pallet or box gets a unique ID
- F. Containers are rate shopped through the TMS and the carrier is selected. Tracking labels print for each container. The TMS contacts the carrier for pick up
- G. When carrier is manifested the related orders close

Transportation (TMS)

Too achieve optimum fulfillment efficiency WMS123 should be integrated with a TMS, which will automate package registration, label printing, and rate shopping. TMS interfaces also return tracking detail and freight cost data, which is used in freight billing. WMS123 offers integrations to major carriers like FedEx, UPS, and Purolator, as well as multi-carrier TMS systems such as Ship Engine and TechDinamics

Inventory Management
